2021 Photography Competition

Winning entries will be included in the Brecon Rotary 2022 Calendar

Last year Brecon Rotary Club successfully produced its first charity calendar, which included photographs taken by Rotary members. This year we are inviting members of the public –to enter a photography competition where they can have their photographs included in next year's charity calendar.

Aims of the competition

To generate enthusiasm for and interest in photography
To inspire people to capture great images of Brecon & its surroundings area
To encourage people to consider the nature which exists locally - in Brecon & the surrounding area
To collect photographs for Brecon Rotary Club's 2022 charity calendar

The theme of the competition is ' The nature of Brecon and its surrounding area throughout the seasons'. This is deliberately intended to be open to a wide variety of interpretations and the Judges will be looking for an imaginative interpretation, as much as technical competence.

Sections of the competition:-

The competition is open to everyone and there are 2 sections:-

Adult section for all adults aged 16 or over on 30 April 2021

Children section for children of all ages under 16 living in the areas served by Brecon and Gwernyfed schools

Rules of the competition:-

1. The location of the photograph should be stated in the covering e-mail. Images should be taken and presented in the landscape format, not portrait, for the purposes of printing onto the charity calendar.
2. All images should be saved as a .jpeg file and be of sufficient size to allow for good quality printing onto the charity calendar; a minimum 300 pixels per inch is recommended.
3. If the photograph includes an image of a person, then please confirm that you have the authority of the that person to submit your photograph into this competition and if of a child, then please confirm that you have obtained the consent of that child's parent/guardian for your photograph to be submitted.
4. All entries must be submitted in digital format by way of attachment to an e-mail and sent to breconrotaryphotos@btinternet.com
5. The e-mail should state the full name of the photographer, date and location of photograph, which category the image is being submitted into and, for the children's section, the entrant's date of birth. Please also include a mobile phone number and for children, please confirm that you have the permission of a parent/guardian to enter the competition and your parent's name.
6. All entrants will retain copyright to their images but by submitting an image to be included in this competition, the entrant agrees that their image can be used, free of charge, by Brecon Rotary Club for publicity purposes and may be included in its 2022 calendar which will be sold to raise funds for charities supported by Brecon Rotary Club

7. Entries must be sent by way of e-mail by midnight Friday 30 April 2021; entrants may submit multiple images, subject to a maximum of 3 per person.
8. The competition will be judged by a panel of 4 members of Brecon Rotary Club. Their decision will be final. The judges will assess the images based on artistic interpretation of the theme, originality and technical competence with particular regard to exposure and composition.
9. There will be a £50 cash prize for First and £25 for Second place, in each category. Entrants whose images are selected will also receive a copy of the completed calendar
10. Judging will take place in early May and the winners and runners up will be notified as soon as possible.
11. All information and images submitted for this competition will be used only within the parameters stated in the rules. Selected images may be displayed in the calendar with location and the photographers' name. All other information and images will be deleted after the conclusion of the competition.
